□ **Background**

Currently, Korean governments are actively pursuing immigrants' integration policy. Alongside current ad hoc national integration programmes in Korea, lively discussion is also made among academics, policy-makers and NGOs. Nonetheless, most integration programmes and discussions rarely take views of immigrants into account, nor intend wider engagement of immigrants in the host society. In this context, the 1st Special Edition of Global Migration Trend is calling for papers which can draw particular attention to the implication of integration policy on immigrants' engagement in the host society.

□ **Theme**

:Integration Policy and Immigrants' Engagement In the Host Society

*Integration Policy includes all relevant policies in the area of politics, economics, culture as well as public policy in health, education, employment and housing that is purported to integrate immigrants in the host society.

□ **Suggested Topics**

- Integration policies and its implication on labour participation of immigrant women
- Integration policies and its impact on immigrants' engagement at a local level
- Including ethnic minorities in policy-making: the consultative role of the immigrant community
- Media representations of immigrants and the consequences for integration
- Any other topic relevant to integration policy and civil, political and cultural engagement of immigrants

□ **Deadline and Way of Submission**

- Please provide around 500-word abstracts (use the format attached) by 5 Aug 2010
- Three successful candidates will be announced on 10 Aug 2010
- Submission of full text should be made by 3 Sept 2010

- Format requirements for paper submission
 - ① Citation and reference should be inserted as footnote; Papers written in English should be in APA style;
 - ② The length of the paper should be within 1,500-2,000 words/characters incl. footnotes;
 - ③ Previously published papers will not be accepted;
 - ④ Author should provide a 75-100 words bio and contact information.
- Language: Korean or English
- The author of the chosen paper will be paid 400,000KRW.
